under COVID-19 Restrictions

Entry conditions apply

From 24th July 2020, Clubs are required to have a COVID-19 Safety Plan registered with the NSW Government which includes the appointment of a COVID-19 Safety Marshal and the mandatory register of patrons on arrival and departure. We have a registered plan and our COVID-19 Safety Marshal continues to be Ms Birutė Alekna.

If you are not well, please do not come to the Club.

Capacity of the premises is subject to the 4m squared density rule, which for us is 150 patrons.

Weddings and commercial functions are limited to 150 people. Singing, dancing, mingling are not allowed.

Funerals and wakes are limited to 100 people.

Restaurant bookings are 10 persons per table.

Patrons are required to:

- register on arrival/departure;
- observe 1.5m social distancing;
- be seated unless ordering food/beverage or using bathroom;
- sanitise and wash hands regularly;
- avoid shaking hands or hugging each other;
- pay by credit card wherever possible.
